


## Turning On

### **CARE & MAINTENANCE**

Do not set liquids on machine. Any liquids will cause irreversible damage.

Clean vinyl sides with windex and cotton rag, or a damp cotton rag.

The monitor is protected by the outside glass and is surrounded with material that will keep dust off the actual monitor, so you will not need to clean the monitor itself. To clean the glass use a microfiber cloth to avoid scratches. DO NOT soak screen with cleaner or water, which may run down between the screen and the monitor and cause damage.
